What are the requirements I need to take this course?

- A bachelor degree.
- Have a minimum specific training or experience as a teacher of Spanish as a foreign language.
- In case of non native speaks, holding a degree in Spanish language & literature, or a C1 DELE diploma.

Will I be able to take part in a DELE as an examiner after this course?

After successfully completing the course, you will receive a certificate and your own official DELE examiner code for the level A1-A2/B1 for Young Learners.
