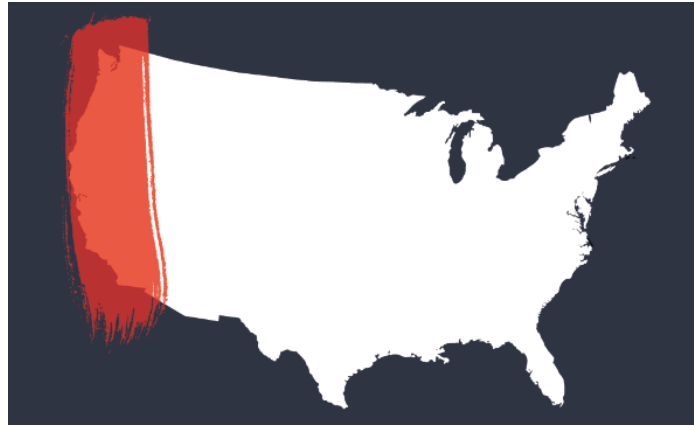

Tell me who you teach, and I'll tell you what resources to use

It is becoming increasingly easy to find or create resources for the classroom. Traditional textbooks and photocopies are giving way to game boards, infographics, hands-on activities, and countless ideas designed to make learning more engaging for our students. But how can we know, before bringing a resource into the classroom, whether it will really work for our students?

We assume that teachers have a thorough command of the curriculum for each age group, but we often overlook the most appropriate way to present it. Is a board game like *Parcheesi* suitable for a class of five-year-olds? Is it too long for their attention span? Is it too easy for adults, leaving them bored? If so, what kind of game board would be the best choice?

In this webinar, we will explore which types of classroom resources are most effective for different age groups and educational needs, helping you choose materials that keep boredom and frustration out of your classroom. Throughout the session, we'll share practical examples and show you where to find each of the ideas we recommend.
